



TEDxLSSC 2019 Art Project Requirements

The theme of this year's TEDxLSSC is transformation. Create an art object (painting or drawing) that expresses this theme and it's meaning to you using whichever medium you prefer.

Your art submission must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Any size is acceptible
- 2. Must represent this year's theme of transformation
- 3. You must use the app Lapseit to record the progress of your creation. These videos will be played during TEDxLSSC 2019. See handout on reverse for more info on Lapseit and instructions
- 4. All art submissions must be submitted in physical format to Kevin Arms. Please contact ArmsK@lssc.edu to arrange delivery
- 5. Video submissions may be provided on a USB drive. See handouts for details on what is expected.
- 6. All submissions are due by February 1, 2019.





TEDxLSSC 2019 Art Project Requirements

If selected, in addition to displaying your artwork in the gallery at our TEDx event, we would also like to show footage of your creation evolving from the stage. To that end, we will be asking you to create a timelapse video of your process. This video should capture 10, 1-second clips of your piece coming together. In order to take the video, we'll be asking you to do the following:

- Download the Lapse It app for your phone (http://www.lapseit.com/)
- Pick a spot to set up your camera. It should be no more than 3 feet away from your painting, and the painting must take up the whole viewfinder in the app. Ideally, we'd like everyone to set up their cameras exactly 2 feet away, but if you can't fit the whole canvas in the viewfinder from 2 feet away, you may move up to 3 feet.
- Set up your camera so that it is absolutely, positively, 100% still
- Take the 1 second video. Continue 10 times until the painting is complete.
